


# **COVID-19: Texas Update**

March 25, 2020

## 1. The day of the shelter-in-place order ...

Several of Texas' large urban areas are now under shelter-in-place orders ... including Harris County (Houston) and the City of Dallas. In all, at least 11 counties and 5 cities have issued similar orders.

Meanwhile, Governor Abbott has not issued a statewide shelter-in-place order, citing among other things, that the number of counties *without* a case (189 counties) vastly outnumbers those *with* a confirmed case (65 counties) of COVID-19. See below ...



The Governor's balancing act has <u>drawn praise</u> from rural counties ...

The White House has advised any <u>travelers from NY should self-quarantine</u> ... <u>In a tweet</u>, Governor Abbott says he'll address the issue this week.

#### 2. Confirmed cases rise ... so do deaths ...

In his press conference today, Governor Abbott updated the public on the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in the state – 715 – and the number of deaths – 11. Both numbers represent significant increases since the Governor's last press conference on Sunday.

Flanked by medical professionals and pallets of medical equipment, the Governor also announced that his recently formed <u>Supply Chain Strike Force</u> <u>has procured \$83 million in Personal Protective Equipment</u>. The order includes the future receipt of approximately 200,000 masks per day by next week.

The Governor also announced an additional <u>executive order</u> which requires hospitals to send daily reports to the state detailing hospital bed capacity and obliges any testing facility to send daily reports concerning COVID-19 testing.

The Governor directed all Texans interested in donating PPE or in volunteering to pitch in via <u>www.texas.gov</u>.

#### 3. Trump aims to lift lockdown by Easter ...

Echoing comments from the past several days, <u>President Trump continues to</u> <u>voice concern over a prolonged lockdown</u> ... going so far today as to say he is aiming to restart the economy by Easter.

In Texas, the unemployment rate has likely already ballooned to 9%, up from an all-time low of 3.5% in January ... <u>the Comptroller warns we could see</u> <u>double digits soon</u>.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average surged in its <u>largest percentage jump since</u> <u>1933</u> (more than 11 percent) ...

Meanwhile, parts of the nation's economic engine pivot to providing solutions to the medical supply shortage ... Ford is working with 3M and GE Healthcare to retrofit its factories to help with the supply of respirators ... and <u>GM is looking to join forces with ventilator maker Ventec Life Systems</u>.

Abroad, <u>Prime Minister Modi has put India on lockdown</u> ... 1.3 billion Indians will be on lockdown for at least 21 days.

### 4. BREAKING ... Congress agrees to \$2 trillion stimulus ...

Late last night, Republicans and Democrats finally agreed to a  $3^{rd}$  stimulus bill ... the bill is expected to pass later today.

Although the bill's text had not been made public, the bill is expected to have:

- Direct payments to individuals ...
- Loans for distressed companies ...
- Funding for hospitals ...
- Relief for cash-strapped state and local governments.

That is all today ...
