

COVID-19: Texas Update



1. WHAT TO WATCH ... Governor Abbott to host press conference this afternoon ...

Governor Abbott will hold a press conference at 2:00 pm (CDT) on Tuesday ... Fox 7 in Austin will be live streaming the press conference ...

While it is not clear what will be announced, Friday, April 3 marks the end of Governor Abbott's <u>statewide mitigation measures</u>, which limited gatherings to less than 10, closed schools, and prohibited dining in at restaurant and bars.

Here's a different look at case projection in Texas ... forming the backdrop upon any decision from the Governor ... from IHME.



The press conference comes on the heels of President Trump's decision to extend federal mitigation guidance through April 30 ... and the <u>suggestion</u> over the weekend from President Trump that new measures/guidance might be forthcoming today.

2. FDA announces Emergency Authorization of therapeutics ...

Over the weekend, the <u>FDA approved wider-spread use of the anti-malarial</u> drugs hydroxychloroquine and chloroquine ...

The FDA had previously permitted their use in clinical trials ... The FDA's formal authorization can be found here.

FDA has provided <u>guidance</u> to both consumers and healthcare providers on the "off-label" use of the two drugs to treat COVID-19.

3. Other tidbits ...

CMS has approved Texas' Section 1135 Waiver ... a quick run down of the flexibilities provided by the waiver can be found here.

• CMS also approved regulatory changes designed to increase the treatment capacity of hospitals ... Fact Sheet.

A federal judge in Texas has <u>ordered</u> that abortion clinics may remain open and operational despite the cancellation of all "elective procedures" in response to COVID-19.

Similar orders were entered in Ohio and Alabama.
